

## Conditions of an Approved Manager Certificate

### Administration

#### The holder of an approved manager certificate must:

1. Allow the PLA, or an officer appointed by the PLA, to enter and inspect the brothel premises or any part therein and all operational aspects of the brothel business. This includes being able to speak privately to any person within the brothel without impediment or presence of the licensee or approved manager; and
2. Provide upon request by the PLA, or any officer of the PLA, and allow any officer of the PLA to inspect, examine, take extracts from, make copies of or take possession of any report, document or thing, which may relate to the operations of the licensed brothel; and
3. Not apply for a licence or permit under the *Liquor Act 1992*; and
4. After becoming aware of a change in the information given in the application for the certificate, advise the PLA in writing within 10 days of becoming aware of the change; and
5. Not work at a licensed brothel that is not stated in the certificate; and
6. When the manager is personally supervising the brothel assume the obligations and responsibilities held under Brothel Licence Conditions of the licensee in the absence of the licensee; and
7. Give the Authority an annual return, in the approved form, about the information given for the application for the certificate at least 3 months before the anniversary day (the date in each year that is the anniversary of the grant of the approved manager's certificate); and
8. Pay the annual certificate fee and the annual return fee prescribed under *Prostitution Regulation 2000* at least 3 months before the anniversary day (the date in each year that is the anniversary of the grant of the approved manager's certificate); and
9. Not personally supervise a licensed brothel without holding a current Senior First Aid Certificate and CPR component. Evidence of currency is to be produced on submission of an annual return, or at any other time on request of an officer of the PLA.

### Brothel Operations

#### The holder of an approved manager certificate must:

10. Not unfairly penalise any sex workers, by whatever means; and
11. Not coerce or harass any sex worker; and
12. Not either directly or indirectly compel a sex worker to service a client or compel a sex worker to provide a particular service; and
13. Not in any way obstruct or hinder an authorised officer of the Prostitution Licensing Authority in the exercise of his or her performance of duties.
