APPLICATION FOR VARIATION OF AN APPROVED MANAGER'S CERTIFICATE

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. This form is used by an approved manager to apply to be authorised to work at an additional or different brothel to that already listed on the certificate.
2. In applying to add a new brothel to your certificate, you must also attach a letter of "intent to employ" signed by the brothel licensee.
3. This form asks for the name/s of licensed brothels for which you are already an approved manager and that you wish to remain on your certificate. It is important that you list each licensed brothel at which you currently work (no matter how often).
4. Names of brothels not confirmed will be taken as formal notification that you are no longer working at that brothel and it will be removed from your new approved manager's certificate. You will not be able to work at brothels that are not confirmed by you.
5. A minimum of two business days is required for processing.
